The implementation of this technology allows the airport to handle more airlines and more operations in less facility space. Equally as important, this technology greatly reduces airline costs, as the airport is providing the necessary technology infrastructure that they require to operate. These reduced costs mitigate airline risk and makes the decision to fly to the airport or add frequencies infinitely easier, enhancing the airport's competitive advantage. This operational flexibility is especially important at an airport like Nassau where it is typical to expand and contract schedules on a seasonal basis.
